

TOWN OF GIBRALTAR
SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE
1988-02

The Town Board of the Town of Gibraltar does ordain as follows:

Section 1, Snow and Ice Removal:

- A. In the areas designated on the attached map, all sidewalks shall be kept clean of snow and ice at the expense of the owners of the4 lots and portions of lots abutting thereon. If the owner or occupant of such lot or part of such lot shall allow snow or ice to remain upon any sidewalk abutting thereon for a period of 24 hours after the snow ceases to fall, then the Town chairman, any Supervisor, Constable or other person or persons designated by the Town Board shall proceed forthwith, without any order or notice to such owner or occupant to cause the snow and ice to be removed. The expenses thereof shall be assessed against the abutting property.

- B. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited directly or indirectly, snow or ice from private property upon town, county or state right of way, streets, alleys, parking lots, docks or other property, except in the area designated above in Section A, where snow and ice is required to be removed within a 24 hour period after snowfall ends, the owner or occupant may pile the snow and/or ice in the street in an area between the curb and three feet into the street

Section 2, Penalty:

Any person who violates Section 1.B. of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$100, together with the costs of prosecution. Each day of a violation shall be considered a separate and distinct violation.

This Ordinance is hereby adopted and shall become effective upon passage and publication.
