

TOWN OF GIBRALTAR
ORDINANCE NO. 1998-03
FINES AND PENALTIES ORDINANCE
AMENDING ORDINANCES 84-3, 87-11, AND 93-2

The Town of Gibraltar does hereby adopt this ordinance amending ordinances 84-3, 87-11, and 93-2, in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes and specifically Chapters 340, 345, 346 and 349.

Ordinance 84-3, Ordinance 87-11 and Ordinance 93-2 are hereby amended to contain the following provisions regarding enforcement, fines and penalties:

- A. Towing. Any vehicle or trailer found in violation of the above ordinances may be towed at the expense of the owner and, in order to recover the vehicle, the owner shall be responsible for any charges for removal, moving or towing and storage of said vehicle or trailer.
- B. Penalties. In addition, any person or persons violating any provisions of the above ordinances shall be fined \$25.00 for the first offense, and \$50.00 for the second or subsequent offense within one year of a previous offense, together with the costs and other penalties as provided under chapter 345 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Section 349.13 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and attorney fees and court costs to the limit allowable by law.
- C. Issuance of Citations. The police or constable for the Town of Gibraltar, if any, and any and all deputy sheriffs for the County of Door, may issue a citation to the owners, or operators of vehicles and trailers in violation of any of the above ordinances, which citation shall conform to Uniform Traffic Citation provisions set forth in Chapter 345 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The citation shall further provide the procedure for paying the penalty prescribed herein.
- D. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
- E. The above ordinances shall be enforced according to Section 3345.20 to and including Section 345.53, and Chapter 799 of the Wisconsin Statutes, together with Chapter 349.

The remainder of Ordinances 84-3, Ordinance 87-11, and ordinance 93-2 shall continue in full force and effect in all respects not inconsistent with the foregoing.

BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing amendatory ordinance be adopted and shall become effective on passage and publication.
