

**TOWN OF GIBRALTAR ORDINANCE**  
**REGARDING LAKE MACKAYSEE**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 2000-01**

A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATER OF MACKAYSEE LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Town board of the Town of Gibraltar does ordain as follows:

Section I.      Applicability and Enforcement

- (a)      The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of MacKaysee Lake.
- (b)      This ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Gibraltar, the Town constable, the town Police Officer, and such additional persons as may be designated by Resolution from time to time.

Section II.     Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreations consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III.    State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV.    Definitions

- (a)      “Slow-No-Wake” means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Section V.     Controlled Area

No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of MacKaysee Lake at any time.

Section VI.    Posting Requirements

The Town of Gibraltar shall place and maintain notice of this ordinance at Lake MacKaysee.

Section VII.   Penalties

Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in s 30.80, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section VIII. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Gibraltar Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX. Effective Date

This Ordinance will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
